Dr. HAIG A. RUSHDOONY 1925-2010



We are deeply saddened to news of the passing away of one of our beloved missionaries supported by the Gilead family¹. Dr. Haig Rushdoony, went to be with the Lord on last Thursday, July 22. He was the co-founder of the Macedonian Outreach, a Christian charitable organization, which helps meet the spiritual and physical needs of people in the Balkan Peninsula of Southeastern Europe which is: Albania, Bulgaria, Greece, Romania, and the former Yugoslavian states of Bosnia, the Republic of Macedonia (FYROM) and Serbia.

Many people read the Bible, but Haig lived it. He especially loved the Book of James and his life was epitomized by James 1:22 that says, "But be doers of the word, and not hearers only..." Haig poured his life into the Macedonian Outreach for the last 20 years of his retirement life and will be sorely missed by all those he touched around the world and especially by his loving wife, and fellow servant of the Lord, Vula, who co-founded the ministry with him. Both of them visited our church in the past. We especially appreciate Vula for her continual visit and ministering to the Gilead family even during the sickness of her husband.

He was an accomplished educator and professor in various universities. Yet the amazing mission call from the Lord came to him at his retirement and so he and his wife followed faithfully and wholeheartedly to serve the people in the Macedonian regions. In his obituary, it wrote: All of this accomplishment however did not measure up to his service to his Lord Jesus Christ whom he loved and served to the very end. Indeed Dr. Rushdoony was a faithful and true servant of God who had lived and walked a life of an exemplary missionary. May
