
### **Grumble or Grow**

#### The number one obstacle of spiritual growth was Israel's constant "grumbling" in the wilderness...




#### Over a period forty years, God provided for their needs, but still Israel grumbled and grumbled...



Israel was scattered (Gk. diaspora)





James gives us a logical reason why we should all be joyful!








4 Let perseverance finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything.

And when one perseveres, our faith becomes more mature and complete!



5 If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you.
This spiritual wisdom is available to you, but there is a catch.



6 But when you ask, you must believe and not doubt, because the one who doubts is like a wave of the sea, blown and tossed by the wind.
And when you ask, you ask in confident faith.





7 That person should not expect to receive anything from the Lord.
If one does not ask in faith, they shouldn't be surprised if they don't receive an answered prayer.





## 8 Such a person is double-minded and unstable in all they do. A double-minded person is non-committal towards God.





James 4:4, Adulterers and adulteresses! Do you not know that friendship with the world is enmity with God? Whoever therefore wants to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God.



When we are tested--let us abstain from grumbling as is our want!
When grumbling grows, faith decreases.
However, when faith grows, grumbling decreases.
