Faith of our Fathers | Devotion on Hebrews 11:8-12 | Fri, Apr 30 Prayer Meeting - Annie Ching

- The Hebrews writer knows the scripture. In the course of one chapter, he cites the hall of faith.
- Faith is the single most important element to know God, "without Faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe"
- Each faith warrior is by no means perfect. They have sinned just like us and weak as we are. But each has accomplished something extraordinary, something above & beyond their power.
- What makes them different? They trust in God, and step forward in faith.
- God opens the door, but he does not give full account of what's ahead. We must obey once we are assured of God's call. "By faith Abraham obeyed when he was called... And he went out, not knowing where he was going" verse 8
- A man of faith is a man of adventures. The safest place is the rest home. Confined to the four walls, being fed, clothed and looked after. Is that our spiritual journey? That has been my experience this year.
- But we desire a better, that is, a heavenly country.
