Annie gives devotion from Psalm 91:

- Also known as the soldier's psalm; can also talk about deliverance in the wilderness since written by Moses.
- But equally applicable to us since we are at spiritual battles also.
- Question: why God does not protect Rick Husband, a Christian & Mission commander when the Columbia shuttle exploded on re-entry?
- God is sovereign and wise; He does not do everything in accordance to our desires.
- Some suggest this talks about millennial future, see Isaiah 65:24-25 & 11:5-8
- This Psalm is not a pledge of unqualified physical protection to all believers for all time in all circumstances. But do claim protection except when God in His love and wisdom allow it for the ultimate good.
- Personal application is Robert & Annie's trip to the inner part of FuZhou. How God in verse 11 that sends His angels to guard us (a fire department vehicle to lead our path in zero visibility), verse 12 "bear you up when you strike your foot against a stone" (Our car hits a stone, which damages the suspension & steering column in mid-way. Yet the driver manages to deliver us to our destination.
- Especially valuable are verse 14 & 15. Out of our deep spirit, we must call on His name, and He will answer. He will be with us in trouble, deliver and honor us
